

He was: An American pastor and Civil Rights Leader who fought for equality, peace and justice. He lived from 1929-1968.


Life's most persistent and urgent question is,

That we can live and work together is our dream too. And we want all students to live up to their full potential.




It is never too early to be thinking about our careers and going to college.




Today's OBJECTIVE: To draw, color in and design our own **Dream Box/Career Cube** which shows the jobs we would like to do to share our lives and work with others.




We will start: Using pencil, draw a picture in each square about your career.
